Language

Bahasa Indonesia is the national and official language in the entire country. It is the language of official communication, taught in schools and spoken on television. Most Indonesians today speak at least two languages or more, Bahasa Indonesia and their local language, of which Indonesia counts more than 300 regional languages.

The official language of the conference is English.

Visa

11 countries and territories are eligible for a "**Visa Free**" facility. Those holding valid passports from the following countries will be granted a non-extendable 30 day Visa-Free Short Visit Permit upon arrival at an Indonesian international gateway without charge:

Nationals of the 64 countries who are going on holiday, business and/or attending conventions, social or cultural visits are allowed to stay in Indonesia for 30 days and can extend for 1 time for 30 days. Visa on arrival are issued upon arrival at the airport's '**International Gateway**'.

Currency

The Indonesian Rupiah is also called IDR. Information of daily exchange rate can be found in newspapers or from the net. Some Indonesian banks provide this on their websites. IDR and US\$ are the most acceptable currencies. Most tourism resorts have money changer facilities. When you are traveling to remote areas, it is advisable to exchange your money and clear your cheques. Credit cards are only acceptable in big hotels, restaurants, shops and traveling agencies.

Airport

Bali Ngurah Rai International Airport, also known as the Denpasar International Airport, is the only airport in Bali.

The airport is located about 16.1 km from Hotel Grand Nikko. The travel takes approximately 22 minutes depending on traffic conditions.

An airport tax of IDR150,000 is levied by airports on departing passengers on international flights and IDR25,000 for those on domestic routes.

Electricity

Electric power supply is 220 volts in all regions. So be careful with your 110-volt electronic equipment. The sockets will only fit with two pins rounded-tip plugs (technically known as Type C, E, and F) or use adaptors.

Wi-Fi

Most hotels and many restaurants in town provide internet connections or free Wi-Fi.

Climate

Bali has a tropical climate with year round temperatures averaging 31 C. High humidity can be expected during the wet season between the months of October - April. It is advisable to wear light pieces of clothings.

Time zone

Bali is in the GMT +8 time zone
