Community Tour

We believe that the community has just as much to teach us, as they can learn from us. For this reason, community tours are planned to be part of the conference programme, allowing participants to immerse themselves in the community and learn more about successful community engagement projects in Bali, Indonesia. Plans are underway for the community tour to include the Jati Luweh Subak system and scholarship programme for Bangli village. The former looks at how the Subak system deals with irrigation to grow local produce, while also understanding further about their culture, faith and local wisdom. The scholarship programme for the Bangli village is a foster education programme for children in that village.
